At Bohunt Worthing enjoyable learning takes place in a stimulating, vibrant environment and within a framework of high expectation. Our challenge-based learning uses the latest technologies, builds motivation and encourages our students to become independent learners equipped with the skills and resilience to succeed in the future.

Respect is the bridge between enjoyment and achievement.


We promote a strong sense of self-worth combined with a respect for others. Consistently high expectations are embedded within an environment that is founded on mutually respectful relationships between students, staff and parents.

On choosing Bohunt Worthing, students are placed in one of three Houses, made up of tutor groups from each year. The Houses are effectively small schools within the School, which enable students to support each other and assume leadership under the guidance of tutors, Achievement Coordinators and Senior Leaders. The House system ensures that our young people are nurtured during the transition from Primary School and throughout their five years with us.

Our learners' sense of ownership and belonging is fostered by encouraging them to perform in school assemblies, help maintain their school environment, support their chosen charities and represent the school in local, national and international contexts.

The personalised curriculum provides students with an equality of opportunity that ensures all learners achieve, whatever their interests and strengths.

The ability to stretch and nurture our more able students is demonstrated by Bohunt Worthing’s unparalleled wealth of opportunities. The provision of high quality learning and teaching is our core purpose. Students who attend Bohunt Worthing make far greater progress than similar students nationally.

The school ethos embodies a climate wherein the success of all members of our community is shared and celebrated on a weekly basis. To understand the achievements and ongoing needs of each individual student we assess, analyse and report progress regularly. At Bohunt Worthing we are implementing the best practice demonstrated across the Trust. Bohunt Liphook were recently awarded the TES ‘Overall School of the Year’, winning the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Maths) Leader Award, receiving over 400 visitors a year (including high ranking ministers, business leaders and international educators). Their work has been used as a case study by Ofsted, SSAT and Apple. In addition, Bohunt Worthing has taken the lead on new initiatives such as the iPad scheme, Mandarin for all and embedding challenge based learning in the curriculum.


We give our learners the opportunity to develop the mindset, skills and confidence to become leaders.

Highly qualified staff offer exceptional experiences outside of the curriculum and beyond the school gates. Students are challenged to work things out for themselves, take risks and experience new ideas, emotions and activities.
