Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you have had a wonderful summer and our students are ready and looking forward to the new academic year ahead. We have been busy putting everything in place to ensure a smooth and successful start to our new extra-curricular programme. Tutors will be working closely with students to support them in choosing at least one club to sign up for and attend over the autumn term. This could be either on a Friday afternoon 1.40-3pm or as part of the weekly school clubs delivered by teachers on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 3.30-4.30pm.

Supervised study time will start on Friday 6 September 2019. Staff will supervise this activity, students are expected to work independently.
