

**RE: Prepare to Perform Evening, 24<sup>th</sup> March 2020**

Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to take this opportunity to provide detailed information regarding the upcoming year 11 prepare to perform evening on the 24<sup>th</sup> March 2020. Similar to that of the previous 'Core' prepare to perform evening, you will not book appointments to see individual teachers. Instead, the event will give you the opportunity to attend a series of workshops delivered by your child's option subject teachers. Each workshop will run for 20 minutes, and you will have the opportunity to attend 4 sessions which will cover all of your child's option subjects.

The event will start at **18.00** with an introduction in the Main Hall and will finish at approximately **20.15**. Parents and students will branch out into multiple teaching rooms depending on your child's timetable and option blocks. There will also be the opportunity to have an open question and answer sessions with subject leaders and senior leadership at the end of the evening.

Options subjects are likely to cover the following topics, and we feel this will be extremely important to help you support your child in the build up to their GCSE examinations. A similar evening has already taken place for core subjects (English, Maths and Science) so they will not be represented during this event.
