



New Key Worker Information

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our support of the community we want to play our part in helping Key Workers continue to work. To help us plan we need everybody who qualifies as a key worker to let us know even if you will not need childcare because this might change over time.

The government guidance is very clear that young people, even key workers should not come back to school if they are old enough to be at home or there is somebody else to look after them (not elderly relatives).

Following the release of the key worker list by the government yesterday and to enable us to plan numbers involved in our partial opening next week. Please can you take the following actions:

1. If you have no key workers as part of your household - **NO ACTION REQUIRED**
2. If you have completed our previous 'BOHUNT WORTHING PARENT/CARER Survey' - This is now closed. **NO ACTION REQUIRED**
3. If based on the most recent key worker list below you qualify and **have not** completed our previous survey please complete this new updated version by 13:00pm today: <https://forms.gle/DGBjzkfT5oBwTAc37>

Key workers are classified as :

- Care / Social Workers
- Key Public Services - (Justice system, journalist, broadcaster, funeral workers)
- Essential Local Government
- Essential utilities, communication and finance
