



Home Learning update

Dear Parent / Carers

We hope you are all well and would like to thank you for your support in what has been our very first week for home learning.

We will be sending you a survey this afternoon with some feedback so we can understand how well it is going and any comments that could help further development.

This afternoon during period 5 and 6 all staff will be looking at their timetabled lessons from Monday and Tuesday, including which students have logged in during or after the lesson time, and submitted work. If they have seen there has been no apparent interaction from a student in their lesson they will be using class charts to record this as 'Missed Remote Learning'.

This will automatically send you an email which will detail the subject and the teacher, but not the lesson slot that was missed. We recognise under the current circumstances there are a range of reasons why a student may have missed some of their learning. We will be using the overview data across the two days to contact parents of students with little evidence of remote learning completed, to better understand the reasons for this, and offer help and support if needed.

If you receive a class charts notification this afternoon please discuss this with your child, and if you feel it is necessary, communicate with the teacher by emailing them directly.

This is an automated system and no judgements will be made that will affect your child's behaviour record. This is simply a way for us to better understand how home learning is working and engage with families that may need more help.
