



Year 7 Virtual ERA week 22-26th June

Dear Parent / Carer,

I am writing to you today to provide details of your son / daughters upcoming virtual ERA week. We feel strongly that despite the challenges faced, we would put together a programme of activities for students to break away from the norm and still have the opportunity to have a series of enriching experiences during ERA week.

During ERA week (22-26th June) students will have no work set by their normal class teachers. Instead they will be set an assignment in their google tutor classroom. Within the assignment will be links to activity instructions and a copy of their ERA passport which I will discuss shortly. Year 7 Overview

ERA passport:

Every student will be assigned their own ERA passport. This is a document for students to upload their evidence and reflections of the activities into. The ERA passport is already semi structured to support students in how to present their evidence. However, the students should be encouraged to make their passport their own and if they want to create an original design then they should do so. Tutors will review each student passport and prizes will be awarded to students who complete their passport and those who go above and beyond will be recognised as well.
