We are delighted to publish our extra-curricular programme for the Autumn term. You'll see that all activities are offered to individual year groups so that students can remain in their bubbles. The timetable includes teacher led activities running Monday to Thursday from 3.40pm -4.40pm. Our Friday offer, which is delivered by external providers, will run from 1.50pm to 3.10pm. It is our expectation that all students commit to attending at least one club a week, with a varied programme of over 60 clubs on offer each week, we hope there is something for everybody to become involved in.

This week students will be signing up for their chosen activity during tutor time. You will receive confirmation of the activity your child has chosen by email later this week. Friday activities will start on 18th September and all other clubs begin the week of 21st September. We ask please for your support in encouraging your child to attend each week. If your child is unable to attend on a Friday afternoon, please contact the school office in advance. Attendance of ten clubs every term is rewarded with ten ERA points.

We are very pleased to be working again with Brighton and Hove Albion in the Community, semi professional footballer Maykol Sabino, best selling cartoon artist, James Parsons and The Helen O'Grady School of Drama. We are also introducing Illustration, Ukulele, handball, yoga and mindfulness activities. There are three paid clubs running on a Friday, this is indicated on the timetable, please visit our parent pay portal for more information.
