Dear Parent/Carer,

The government released the latest guidance for Schools at 4:30pm on Wednesday. Both the trust and the school have been working to decide the implications for us in terms of our risk assessment and school structure. We are also considering the feedback survey from you as parents given to us over half term and some of the clarification and changes requested in this.

Although the second lockdown started yesterday the guidance as it stands does not mean we have to immediately change anything but we do need to make decisions so that we align the expectations set out in our previous approaches with those now released by the government. We will be in touch early next week to share with you our considered response and how we will continue to deliver high quality education within a safe and secure environment.

In the meantime, we continue to ensure students are supported to continue their learning both in and out of school. We have clear approaches for most eventualities and so we will continue this to ensure all are familiar with what they need to do in most scenarios.
