Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the return to school process, we are very pleased to relaunch our Co Curricular offer for the Spring and Summer term. This includes teacher led activities running Monday to Thursday and of course our Friday afternoon provision. Now perhaps more than ever, is a time when students will really benefit from taking part in additional opportunities on offer. The schedule includes subject support groups as well as many sporting and artistic activities which students will not have been able to access fully in the last few months.

It is our expectation that all students commit to attending at least one club a week and many have already signed up for our Spring offer which was launched at the end of the Autumn term. Students should look at the timetable again to check the activity is still running (as we've changed the offer slightly). They can re register for clubs and add options by following the link to the registration form.

Tutors will support students signing up during tutor time as they return this week, I have also ensured that families can access the sign up sheet from home so that you can support your child with the process. The sign up window will end on Friday 12th March.
