



Start of term and COVID update

Dear Parent/Carer

Below is some key information to help with the first couple of days next week and attached is our latest COVID update document that outlines our expectations and measures on site.

Key Information:

- Timetables: your son or daughter should be able to see their timetable on the google calendar app over the weekend. This will tell them whether they need PE kit for their first day of term. If unable to check this then as a precautionary measure any Y11 should bring their PE kit on Monday. Any Y10, any Y9 and only Y8's in Mandela house should bring theirs on Tuesday
- This year we have changed the coding of tutor groups slightly to help both staff and parents identify which house their child is in. The tutor coding has changed from a three letter staff initial to a two letter initial with the third letter in your child's tutor code will be the your child's house. e.g.
 - I0TFU is Miss Fu and will become I0TFM which means they are in Mandela House
 - 9DHU is Miss Hussey will become 9DHT which mean they are in Turing House
- On Thursday the school photographer will be visiting and will take formal photos of all students for our records which parents will have the option to purchase.
- Once everybody has returned to school lockers will be available for an annual rental fee. Details for how to pay and the distribution of keys will be sent out next week.
- Year 7 have a collapsed timetable day of varied transition activities on Monday so do not need to worry about their timetable or being prepared for particular subject lessons until Tuesday
- Year 7 Parents who have not yet visited the school are invited to tour the site led by their child straight after school on either Wednesday or Thursday. Should you wish to do this please arrange to meet your child outside reception at 3:30, sign in and then they can take you round and show you some of their classrooms. Adults attending will need a mask to wear and are asked to observe physical distancing with those outside of their group.

It has been lovely to talk with our returning Y11 and new Y7 students today as they attended for testing and we very much look forward to being back as a whole school next week.
