As the winter term draws to a close we would like to invite students to participate in our Christmas Jumper / Dinner day on Wednesday 15th December.

Christmas Jumpers

On the 15th December, students will be able to come into school wearing their Christmas jumper. We will collect a £1 donation during morning tutor time with proceeds going to Turning Tides, a local charity that supports those who are homeless. The Christmas jumper will replace the school blazer only. **Please note this is not a full non uniform day, students will still be expected to wear the rest of their uniform as per normal.**

Christmas Dinner

As a part of our Christmas jumper day, we will also be serving a Christmas lunch. Students will be able to choose from either

Roast turkey, stuffing, pigs in blanket and cranberry sauce

OR

Vegan beetroot and squash wellington with kale pesto

Both served with roast potatoes, carrots, peas and savoy cabbage with a 'Christmas' chocolate brownie for dessert.

Christmas lunch costs £2.25 and must be paid via school gateway.

The deadline for ordering is the end of Thursday 9th December. Students who have not ordered will not be able to receive a lunch on the day.

Students who normally receive free school meals will automatically have a Christmas lunch ordered for them. Parents can make a choice of the meat or vegetarian option via the school gateway app. **The deadline for making a choice is Thursday 9th December. Those who have not made a selection will automatically be ordered the meat option.**

Important Notice – Students will be able to purchase drinks and sandwiches during their first break. However, in order to facilitate the Christmas lunch there will be no other food provided at lunch. Therefore, if your child is not having the Christmas lunch or does not want to purchase a sandwich at break time please ensure they bring in a suitable packed lunch.
