



Class of 2022 - Year 11 Prom

Dear Parent/Carer

The next few months will fly by and before you know it, it will be time to say goodbye to our Year 11 students. As is custom in many schools across the UK, we'd like to mark this with Bohunt School Worthing Prom! This will be a wonderful opportunity for students to mark the conclusion of their exams and celebrate their hard work alongside their peers and teachers.

The BSW Prom will take place on **Wednesday 29th June** at the stunning **Long Furlong Barn, Worthing BN13 3XN**. We wanted to write to you early in the year because we appreciate this will have a cost attached to it.

The cost of the ticket this year will be approximately **£40 per person**. This includes hire of the venue, attendant staff and facilities, food, unlimited drinks and a disco. Therefore, once the students have arrived there will be no additional costs on the night. The event requires formal dress and **students should arrange their own transport to and from the event**. We will also be offering all students an opportunity to purchase a personalised Leavers Hoodie and details about this will follow later this term.

The payment for the BSW Prom will open on the school gateway at the end of the Spring Term, in April. Payment does not open before then **because to earn an invitation to prom, all students will need to earn at least 85 points on their BSW Prom Passport**. All students are able to earn these points through good attendance, punctuality, participation in lessons, conduct and attendance to after school revision sessions. The Prom Passport was launched to students in a special assembly on Friday and all students have received their passports in tutor time this morning.

Important Information: Tickets are offered to Year 11 students only – **guests are not permitted**. I would expect that any student who wishes to attend the event will be able to do so; however, the Bohunt School Worthing reserves the right to make decisions about the participation of any student in this event should it become necessary, either in the months leading up to the Prom or even on the night itself. Consequently, the school will not be held liable for any costs incurred by you or the student if the decision is made to bar anyone from the Prom.

Should the conduct of any student on arrival or during the course of the evening give a cause for concern, staff from the school and from the venue will take appropriate action: parents will be contacted and asked to collect their son/daughter. Your consent to purchasing a ticket in your son's/daughter's name is therefore only on that understanding. Further information, including menu choices for the meal will follow later this term.

After what has undoubtable been a challenging couple of years for our Year 11 students we hope that the prom passport helps provide a bit of extra motivation to help guide students through the last few months of their secondary education. With the culmination being an opportunity to attend prom and celebrate the end of Year 11 in style!
