Durrington Health Centre are running a walk in vaccine clinic running this Saturday (15th January), and want to get the message out to as many Worthing residents as they can. Taking place between 9.00am to 5.00pm at Durrington Health Centre, the walk in clinic is for **everyone**. *12 years plus for 1st, 2nd or booster doses, *12-15yrs 1st or 2nd dose & 16-17 year olds any dose including boosters 12 weeks after 2nd vaccine and *anyone 18+ that has missed a dose (1st, 2nd or booster) due to Covid – it must be 28 days since positive test or 12 weeks from positive test if under 18.
