Dear Parent/Carer

We hope that you all had an enjoyable Easter break and that your child is looking forward to returning for the summer term. Ahead of the start on Monday, please take a moment to read the below notices and talk through with your child.

Punctuality

It was pleasing to see a significant reduction in lateness to school towards the end of the spring term. Being on time to school is important for a range of reasons and is an important life skill for all young people to carry into their adult lives.

As a consequence, we will continue to monitor lateness with any student late to school twice or more in a two week cycle having a detention on the afternoon of the second late or subsequent late. To improve the speed of communication, parents will receive an email informing them if their child is in detention that evening.

We of course would rather that all students are able to attend school on time and if there are any barriers that are preventing this from happening please contact your child's tutor or achievement coordinator to discuss how we can support your child or yourselves.

Uniform

The start of the summer term will act as a marker for returning to 'normal' school uniform. In short, this means that students are no longer allowed to wear their jackets inside the school building either in lessons or in the corridors.

Instead, students will be expected to wear their blazers inside the school building, with a black Bohunt V jumper being optional underneath.
