



Eco Day- Friday 8th July- non uniform details for that day

Dear Parent/Carer

This Friday 8th July, BSW will be celebrating Eco Day, run by Turing House. The school will be running a range of activities and events to raise money and widen awareness of environmental issues.

Events

Firstly, students can come to school in **non-uniform** but **must wear something green** to show their support for being 'green' / caring for the environment. They will also be expected to **contribute £1** which they will hand to their tutor in form time in the morning. Each tutor group will nominate one student for the best dressed competition!

The following applies regarding non-school uniform:

- School jewellery rules will still apply
- Skirts/shorts must be of a length in line with school policy
- No vest tops
- No drug related logos/inappropriate slogans on clothing will be permitted
- If your child has PE on this day, they must still bring in their PE kit

Secondly, as a school body both staff and students will be attempting to cycle the combined distance to Bohunt Liphook and back on Mr Franklin's exercise bike. Students can sign up to take part in this via their tutor. If students wish to collect sponsorship for taking part they are very welcome, however, this is optional.

Thirdly, over lunch-time students will be able to challenge a number of staff across a variety of fun activities. The cost is **50p** per challenge as students will compete for bragging rights as they aim to beat their chosen teacher! The canteen will also be meat-free on Friday and we are encouraging students to try having a meat-free packed lunch if they do not normally do so.

All funds raised will go towards the school's plan for developing outdoor learning spaces on site and for more recycling bins to be installed.
