As the winter term draws to a close we would like to invite students to participate in our Christmas Jumper / Dinner day on Wednesday 14th December.

Christmas Jumpers

On the 14th December, students will be able to come into school wearing their Christmas jumper. We will collect a £1 donation during morning tutor time with proceeds going to Turning Tides, a local charity that supports those who are homeless. The Christmas jumper will replace the school blazer. **Please note this is not a full non uniform day, students will still be expected to wear the rest of their uniform as per normal.**

Christmas Dinner

As a part of our Christmas jumper day, we will also be serving a Christmas lunch. Students will be able to choose from either

- Roast turkey, stuffing, pigs in blanket and cranberry sauce

OR

- Vegan beetroot and squash wellington with kale pesto

Both served with roast potatoes, carrots, peas and savoy cabbage with a 'Christmas' chocolate brownie for dessert.

Christmas is a time for reflection and coming together to celebrate. **This year we have decided that all students will have a Christmas lunch provided free of charge by the school.** To avoid wastage and to ensure the kitchen freshly prepare the right number of meat and vegetarian / vegan options, we ask that parents access the gateway app to select whether your child would want a free Christmas lunch and to choose a meat or vegetarian option. If your child is in receipt of free school meals they will automatically have one ordered for them but please still access the gateway app to choose whether your child would like a meat or vegetarian option.

The deadline for making a choice is Thursday 8th December.

Important Notice – Students will be able to purchase drinks and sandwiches during their first break. However, in order to facilitate the Christmas lunch there will be no other food provided at lunch. Therefore, if your child is not having the Christmas lunch or does not want to purchase a sandwich at break time please ensure they bring in a suitable packed lunch.
