Please be aware that if a student receives a suspension, spends time in our Reflection Room or has a behaviour record that is more negative than positive, this may mean that they won't be able to attend school trips or at least will trigger a discussion regarding your child's attending the school trip.

If any concerns arise regarding a student's readiness to participate, we will contact parents and carers to arrange a meeting. This will provide an opportunity to review expectations together and discuss any support that may help your young person meet them successfully. Similarly, if you feel your young person may benefit from additional support in any of these areas, please don't hesitate to get in touch with us – we are keen to work with you to ensure every student has the best chance to take part.

Please note that, in line with school and Trust policy, students must maintain good attendance (with the national expectation of 96% or above) and uphold behaviour that reflects our values at all times. We are
