The link between attendance and achievement is clear. Small differences in attendance create large differences in outcomes. Every lesson missed is learning lost, and in a short half term like this, time moves quickly.

I am incredibly proud to share that our February 100 percent club is the biggest it has ever been. Nearly 60 percent of students attended every single day in February. This is a fantastic achievement and reflects the commitment of both students and families. Thank you for prioritising attendance.
